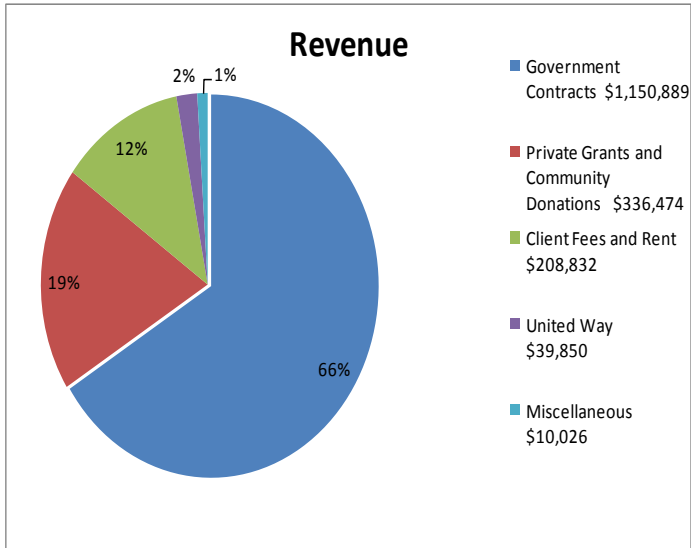

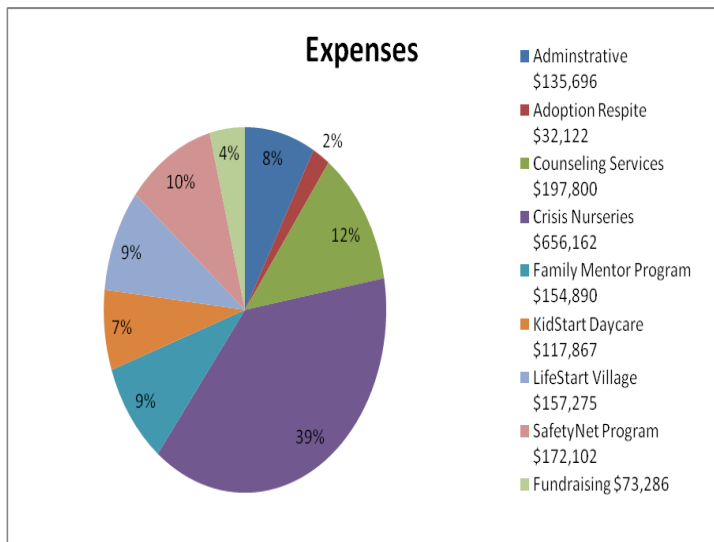

## Crisis Nurseries

Unduplicated Children Served: 2,298

Visits to the Crisis Nursery: 11,947

Meals/Snacks Served: 10,633

Hours of Care: 71,983.75

\*number of children served in Crisis Nurseries increased 25% from last year (2009/10 Fiscal year)

Crisis Nurseries provide free 24/7 care to children ages 11 and under. Parents can bring their children to the Crisis Nurseries up to 72 hours at a time, an unlimited number of times. Crisis Nurseries are used for stressful and emergency situations to help reduce incidents of child abuse. Reasons parents use the Crisis Nurseries include: to attend medical or doctor appointments, to job-hunt or interview, to resolve legal affairs, to take stress breaks, emergency daycare when babysitters call-in sick last minute (daycare service is limited).

## Clinical Services

Unduplicated Clients Served: 307

Number of Therapy Sessions: 2,513

Number of People Attending Community Classes & Support Groups: 425

\*Number of people attending classes increased 32% from last year (2009/10 Fiscal Year)

FSC's Clinical Department offers professional mental health therapy and community classes/support groups to low-income and uninsured individuals and families. Fees are based on both income and ability to pay. Medicaid is accepted. Last year 95 percent of clients were low-to-moderate income, with the vast majority being low to very low income.



## Family Mentor Program

Individuals Served: 535  
Families Served: 130  
Number of in-home visits: 1274 (1911 hours)

\*Number of families served increased 18% from last year (2009/10 Fiscal year)

The Family Mentor Program provides free in-home support to parents and families who are experiencing stress or dysfunction. It is the goal of The Family Mentors to help stabilize families and increase the health and functionality of the family within the context of their own personal home system.

## LifeStart Village

Individuals Housed: 117  
Total Hours of Case Management: 624  
Employment Increase: 40%

LifeStart Village is a transitional housing and self-sufficiency training project for homeless mothers and their children. Here homeless single mothers commit to an intensive program designed in 3 progressive phases to help women go from homeless to home-owners. The program includes weekly case management, mandatory classes, weekly meetings, chores, and other protocols that boast high success rates of transitioning families successfully to permanent housing and self-sufficiency.

## Adoption Respite

Children Served: 96  
Families Served: 27  
Hours of Service: 1,772

Adoption respite provides in-home respite child care at a nominal fee for families who have adopted at least one child from the State

## KidStart Daycare

Children Served: 60

KidStart Daycare is Family Support Center's new professional daycare in Midvale, UT. KidStart accepts State assistance, offers drop-in daycare options, and operates extended hours and weekends in order to help accommodate low-income families whose work schedules fall outside of the 9-5 workday.

## Safety Net

Individuals Served: 1,112

Safety Net is administered by Family Support Center at the request of the Utah Attorney General's office. Safety Net strives to ensure individuals living in polygamous communities have equal access to services and justice, and offer transitional support to those wishing to move out of polygamous communities and into mainstream society.

---

## Volunteer Program

Unduplicated Volunteers: 320

Volunteer Hours Completed: 7,778 hours
